public static void main(String[] args){
```

Scanner inS = new Scanner(System.in);
```

```
System.out.print("Enter the numbers: " );
```

```
int m = inS.nextInt();
```

```
boolean fetch = ( (m > 1) && (m < 100) || m < 0);
```

```
System.out.println("if a number in variable num is between 1 and 100 : "+ fetch);
```
